

# The otter spotter guide

**As you will see our otters have lots of places to hide in their enclosure. So, here are a few tips for spotting our little furry friends:**

- Check their indoor enclosure, they may be tucked up in bed having a sleep or staying out of the rain.
- Check the pond; they often like to play about in the water, swimming in and out of the reeds.
- One of their favourite places to sit and relax is next to the waterfall, you will find them lounging about on the logs.
- They often sit amongst the reeds around the pond, so see if you can see any movement.
- They enjoy spending time in their 'holt' (nest box). Can you see their heads poking out of the entrance?
- For a better chance of seeing the otters come along to their feeds at 11:15 and 14:15.
