

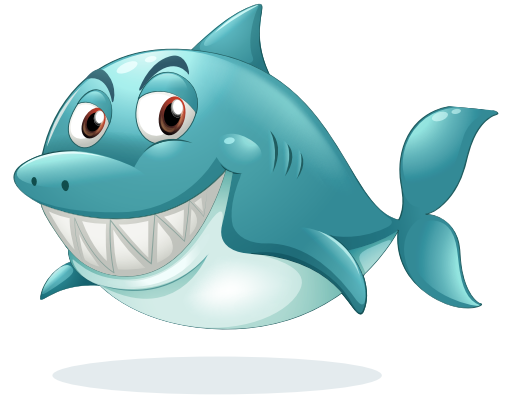
'JAWSOME' SHARKS

Children will be able to discuss and question the differences between Sharks teeth and jaws, gaining understanding in why and how sharks use their teeth.

They learn about where different species of shark live and the dangers to their environments through global warming and other environmental factors.

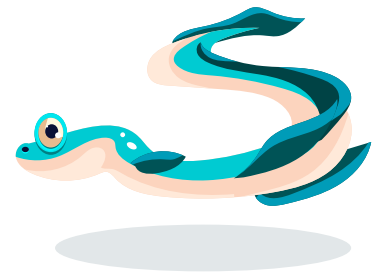


Things to find out.....
