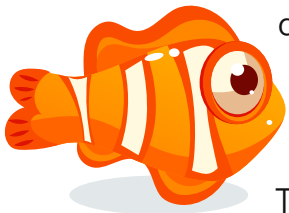


TROPICAL RAINFORESTS

What's it all about?

Children identify different insects, reptiles and marine life that live in rainforests and discuss their feeding processes.

Children will be able to discuss the characteristics of the animals and learn how they have successfully adapted to live in their habitat.



Children learn about changes to the rainforests due to climate change and other environmental factors.
