


# Zig Zag Ocean Book

## Teacher Resource/Instructions


1. Give each child a zig zag book template. Ask them to first fold down the central dotted line.
2. Next, fold along the remaining dotted lines, folding back and forth to create a concertina (zig zag) book.
3. Once folded, show the children how the book opens page by page.
4. Read the story aloud together, one page at a time.
5. Invite the children to draw their own illustrations on each page to match the story.
